Location: Polar Black Zone – Sublevel Archive PHASELINE-6

Subject: Ice-Wall Perimeter Analysis / Highjump Anomalies / Restricted Airspace Protocols

Summary

Recent scans of PHASELINE-6 unearthed a sealed cache labeled AW-PRIME://CONTAINMENT_LOGS, containing decrypted telemetry files, fragmented expedition journals, and redacted military briefs connected to Operation HIGHJUMP (1946–47).

Several data clusters reference a “perimeter structure” at the Antarctic boundary—described variously as:

- a 200–300 ft vertical ice formation,
- a “terminus shelf beyond navigable waters,”
- and in one unredacted entry: “the outer wall.”

Cross-analysis reveals eight separate satellite anomalies where public NASA composites overwrite original frames, suggesting systematic masking of polar regions. Flight-path irregularities confirm a persistent No-Fly Exclusion Radius inconsistent with scientific activity alone.

Recovered Highjump audio logs mention:

- “objects moving faster than any known aircraft,”
- “zones of magnetic instability,” and
- “non-human resistance.”

A correlation spike occurred when these logs were run against The Signal’s July frequency burst; data indicates synchronized interference between Highjump-era anomalies and modern polar distortion signatures.

Vera’s computational assessment indicates a 72–81% probability that the Ice Wall is not purely geological, but part of a broader containment system—its architecture aligning with ancient cosmological texts referring to “the ends of the earth,” “the deep frost boundary,” and “the gates sealed until the appointed hour.”

Analyst Note: The Antarctica perimeter may be a controlled threshold, not an environmental coincidence.

Operatives should monitor public reaction and report the following anomalies:

- flight path deviations over Southern Hemisphere routes
- sudden disappearance of polar satellite imagery
- restricted zones expanding or shifting
- anomalous temperature readings beneath glacial layers
- testimonies from former polar researchers avoiding specifics

Cross-reference all public intel with Vera for authenticity scoring.

Field Intel

Recovered terms from AW-PRIME logs:

- “Perimeter Lock” – boundary threshold activated when unauthorized approach is detected.
- “Polar Gate” – speculative entry point referenced in Highjump addendums.
- “Zone Null” – region where electromagnetic readings collapse to near-zero.
- “Containment Shelf” – engineered structure beneath the visible ice ridge.
- “South Ridge Intercept” – classified encounter logged during Highjump’s early retreat.

Analyst Note: These terms are consistent with a controlled frontier, not an untouched wilderness.
